Does this SDS allow me to understand the risks and steps needed to protect:

- People (my staff, wider community)
- Environment

The 6-point test

1. How old is it? If pre-2002 check with your supplier that it is the most recent.
2. Has it been updated to comply with REACH and GHS/CLP?
3. Are all 16 sections complete?
4. Does section 1 match the product name or synonym?
5. Does section 15 match the product label?
6. Do I understand the risks to people and the environment?
